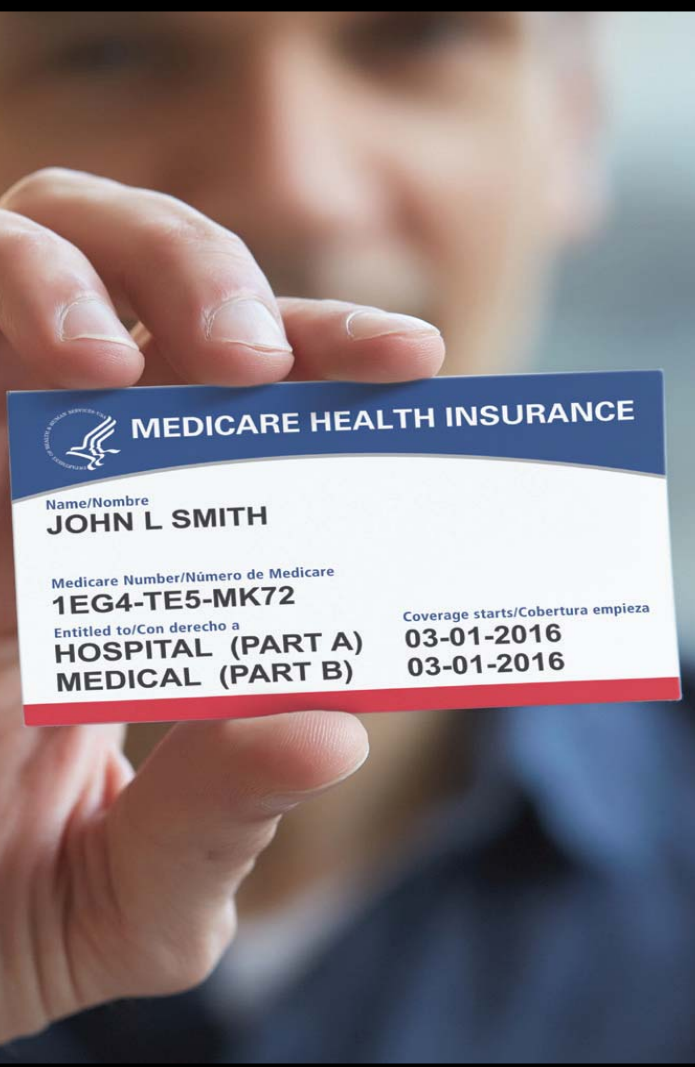


You're Getting a New Medicare Card!

Medicare will mail new Medicare cards between April 2018 – April 2019. Your card will have a new Medicare Number instead of a Social Security Number.

New Survey Process

As you may know, part of Oakview's participation in The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) programs and licensing includes regular, unannounced surveys by the State of Michigan to ensure our compliance with State and Federal rules and regulations. Starting in November 2017 the survey process underwent some changes that we thought you should be aware of. While in the past, interviews of residents and family members has been a portion of the survey, much more emphasis is now being placed on this aspect and Surveyors are now required to see every resident in the building. It is our expectation that in the first 1-2 days, State Surveyors will be going room to room unaccompanied by facility staff to meet with residents for approximately 2-5 minutes as a part of their initial screen to identify any potential concerns they want to take a closer look at. We are sharing this information in hopes that you or your loved one are not caught off guard or surprised by this, and that those of you who may have had interaction with Surveyors in the past are not alarmed by this change. We encourage all residents and family members to be open in sharing your honest thoughts and concerns when approached by any member of the Survey Team. That said, part of our mission is to "strive to provide quality care that will meet or exceed State and Federal health care standards" and your thoughts and concerns are important to us each and every day. Remember that there is always a charge nurse available 24hrs a day to address concerns you may have. Please don't hesitate to reach out to any member of our staff with any questions or concerns you may have at any time.
